CAPTAIN'S KEY DEPENDENT DISTRICT REGULAR BOARD MEETING MARCH 14, 2023

A. CALL TO ORDER

District Manager Jason Pierman called the March 14, 2023, Regular Board Meeting of the Captain's Key Dependent District (the "District") to order at 6:05 p.m. at The Oaks Center located at 2501A Burns Road, Palm Beach Gardens, Florida 33410.

B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION

Mr. Pierman presented proof of publication that notice of the Regular Board Meeting had been published in the *Palm Beach Daily Business Review* on September 30, 2022, as part of the District's Fiscal Year 2022/2023 Meeting Schedule, as legally required.

C. SEAT NEW BOARD MEMBERS

Mr. Pierman noted that Messrs. Mahoney, Jave, and Jones had been sworn in prior to the meeting starting, to Seats 1, 2 and 3, respectively.

D. ADMINISTER OATH OF OFFICE AND REVIEW BOARD MEMBER RESPONSIBILITIES & DUTIES

E. ESTABLISH A QUORUM

Mr. Pierman determined that the attendance of Chairman John Banister, Vice Chairman Russell Jones, Supervisor Trey Mahoney, Supervisor Yefry Jave, and Supervisor Judge Moss constituted a quorum and it was in order to proceed with the meeting.

Staff in attendance included: District Manager Jason Pierman.

F. ELECTION OF OFFICERS

Mr. Pierman explained that with every election or change in the Board, the Board must elect officers. Following a discussion, a **motion** was made by Mr. Jones, seconded by Mr. Banister and unanimously passed to elect the following slate of officers:

Chair: John Banister Vice Chair: Russell Jones Treasurer: Yefry Jave

Assistant Secretary: Try Mahoney Assistant Secretary: Judge Moss

Secretary/ Assistant Treasurer: Jason Pierman

G. ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS TO AGENDA

Mr. Pierman noted that a discussion regarding the Caldwell Pacetti invoice would be added under New Business.

H. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC FOR ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA

There were no comments from the public for items not on the agenda.

I. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. November 8, 2022, Regular Board Meeting

Mr. Pierman presented the minutes of November 8, 2022, Regular Board Meeting for approval.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Mahoney, seconded by Mr. Jones approving the minutes of the November 8, 2022, Regular Board Meeting, as presented, and upon being put to a vote, the **motion** carried unanimously.

J. OLD BUSINESS

1. Discussion Regarding Captain's Landing Cul-de-Sac Drainage Repair

Mr. Pierman explained that he had met a few companies onsite, and no one was able to give a confident proposal, due to the potential issues with the line and limited access. However, the estimates were in the \$30,000 ballpark. Mr. Jones suggested digging around where the pipes connect and injecting around it to seal the connection. Following discussion, the Board consensus was to move forward with that plan, provided it could be done without disturbing the neighbors' hardscaping and landscaping.

K. NEW BUSINESS

1. Consider Proposal for Additional Polymer Stabilizations

Mr. Pierman presented the proposal from Shenandoah. Mr. Jones requested that they backfill dirt where needed. Following discussion, a **motion** was made by Mr. Mahoney, seconded by Mr. Banister, and unanimously passed approving the proposal and an additional not-to-exceed amount of \$3,000 to include the cul-de-sac line.

2. Consider Resolution No. 2023-01 – Adopting a Fiscal Year 2023/2024 Proposed Budget

Resolution No. 2023-01, entitled:

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE CAPTAIN'S KEY DEPENDENT DISTRICT APPROVING A PROPOSED BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023/2024; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Following discussion regarding the cost of repaving the roads and the fact that the District had used capital funds for gate and landscaping related improvements, while at the same time reducing assessments over the years, the Board consensus was to increase assessments by \$500.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Mahoney, seconded by Mr. Jones, and unanimously passed adopting Resolution No. 2023-01, amended with the assessment amount increased to \$3,500, setting the Public Hearing for June 13, 2023.

3. Discussion Regarding Caldwell Pacetti Invoice

Mr. Pierman distributed the Caldwell Pacetti invoice, as well as Ms. Jones' email regarding it. Mr. Jones noted that he did not think that the interaction was equitable for him because the conversations were one-sided. Mr. Banister stated that he was providing Mr. Edwards with information regarding his request for an easement. Following discussion, Mr. Pierman noted that he had brought Mr. Edwards into the discussion and that the majority of the items listed in the invoice were undertaken at his request, in an effort to protect the District. He further explained that Mr. Edwards had reduced his invoice by \$5,000, likely due to the unexpectedly large amount of research that was performed and the fact that Mr. Banister had sent him additional information. Mr. Moss noted that he thought Mr. Edwards did the right thing by reducing his bill in recognition that it may have been one-sided, and that Mr. Edwards was impartial, but that he sees Mr. Jones' point. Mr. Mahoney agreed that there was no malicious intent, and questioned if he would be allowed to contact Mr. Edwards if he had an issue. Mr. Jave recommended that in the future, they appoint an impartial Board Member to speak with the attorney instead of a conflicted Board Member. Mr. Jones requested that Mr. Edwards' invoice be redacted to exclude items related to Mr. Banister's interactions and requests.

Following the meeting, Mr. Pierman reviewed the invoice for only those items that were directly initiated by him as District Manager, for the benefit of the District. The cost for those items was, conservatively, \$4,089, of which \$3,149 was billed.

M. BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS

Mr. Pierman suggested that, considering that a large portion of discussion that takes place in the District meeting is actually POA business, the Board look at dissolving the District and having the POA take over the gate operation. He noted that research would need to be done to explore that possibility. The Board consensus was to move forward with the research.

N. ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to come before the Board, a **motion** was made by Mr. Jones, seconded by Mr. Mahoney and unanimously passed adjourning the Regular Board Meeting at 8:04 p.m.
